Mr. Munkhsukh started his speech by introducing his self to all members present. He mentioned that it is an honor and a great previledge for the Mongolian Ju Jitsu Federation to hold the Ju Jitsu world Championship 2023 this week he also mentioned that this is a very special time of the year for the whole in Mongolia since it is also the Nadam Festival which celebrates Mongolia's culture, history, heritage and their independence. He wished everyone to enjoy the competition and a successful congress. And welcome everyone to experience the history and culture of Mongolia!

4. Mongolian Ju Jitsu Federation Development Report

The Representative of Mongolian Federation stated that apart from the training and producing world standard athletes, they also do many kinds of different projects using the Ju Jitsu health empowerment tool, using health discipline for the youth and children of Mongolia. She also mentioned that with their projects that they do in terms of social responsibility, they have initiated together with the Mongolian Education University which is called JUMP (Annex***). She also introduced one approaching project which they called JuJitsu Palace Child Development Center which has been started last year in the month of October, she mentioned that with that project they are aspiring to create along the way a Ju Jitsu base High School specifically for the rural area kids who have limitations and no access to the city centers. She also added that they are preparing for a Ju Jitsu project tour on the 17th July 2023.

8. JJIF Activities

Media Strategy

JJIF Media Consultant Mr. Haggen Bossdorf started the report, he first introduced his self and mentioned that he is familiar with the ju jitsu sport since 2013 when he was a part of the World Games Organization team in Colombia and since a couple of years, he tried to support JJIF to be in the middle of media strategy especially in broadcasting. He presented to the congress the JJIF Media Strategy for the WC 2023 in Mongolia.

WADA Report

Mr. Joachim Thumfart presented the annual report of doping free to the Congress, he proudly mentioned that they are happy to declare that in the last year they have one cleared case of doping, in JJIF they have some other atypical findings which this athlete was suspended for 4 years, the case is closed until the athlete is allowed to participate again. He also presented the Doping Cases they have and the WADA Compliance check.

Activities and Report in the Board and the JJIF

The President said that he has the best partners in all departments of Ju Jitsu who's making an amazing work and working very hard in different projects in different request that they are receiving in the Federation. He mentioned that the main heart of the organization is Mr Joachim Thumfart who's working a lot for JJIF and the people behind the development of the rules, procedures and working on the evaluation in different fields- Putting criteria, checking the criteria, improving the Ju-Jitsu in all fields, including the technical part of the athletes, improving the refereeing which is very important to Ju-Jitsu. He added that the continental unions are working in very effective way, even though sometimes there are contradictions between ideas and about the way they think of the future of different subject but they still find a way to collaborate and work in all continents in a very good level. He also mentioned that they need more effort from Pan-American Union and African Union.

He also highlights that the JJIF activities is becoming bigger, and they are putting new strategies, new plans in their table for discussion and development including the professional part of Ju Jitsu which will be launch soon. He also said that from the national federations, he can see a lot of improvements in the last 5 years including the years of pandemic where all activities were stopped but despite of that all the NF are getting more and more informed and involved in the JJIF decision making in the future of organizing the Ju Jitsu worldwide.

The president also stated that since last year he the commissions except the commissions who are included in the technical part in order to change the way of approach different items and include as much as possible voices of the athletes, coaches and people who are involved in the management of the national federations of Ju Jitsu. He also mentioned that they had a productive meeting since last year in all disciplines which is now developing rapidly.

Financial Report

Mr Joachim presented the financial report of JJIF he explained the all the assets, expenses and incomes of JJIF from 2019-2023.

Financial Audit: Mr. Joachim has presented to the congress the declaration letter from the two Auditors Mr. Ahmed Janahi and Mr. Rick Frowyn. In the letter they have stated that they have executed the audit in accordance with the set of laws of the JJIF and have randomly investigates the accounting of the year 2022during the European Championship in Israel. They also they declared that there are no irregularities found.

He also presented the consequences of the change of statutes that has been agreed last year that the operational task will be decided by the JJIF board such as Financial, Membership and Statutorily Issues which will go to the JJIF Congress. Operational questions and technical issues should be addressed to the technical commission at first and should be decided by the JJIF board. Technical issues my only brought up to the congress if after evaluation and the technical commission or board will face a major descend or disagreement.

Discussion	Mr. Robert Perc firstly greeted all the members present and congratulate the JJAU for hosting another big event in Ju Jitsu Community. And he also congratulates Mongolian Ju Jitsu federation for their invested effort for organizing the World Championship which is never an easy task. Mr. Robert mentioned that on behalf of the JJEU he would like to recognize the work and the positive attitude of every volunteer in the World Championship. Mr. Fahad Al Shamsi took the opportunity to talk and express his gratitude for hosting the World Championship 4 years in a row in Asia and appreciate the hospitality and warm welcome of the Mongolian people. Mr. Fahad has awarded a trophy to Mr. Bold-Erdene Odsuren for his dedication and outstanding support to JJAU and as well as for his loyalty as founding member of JJAU. He mentioned that they are so happy that everybody is active but many of the proposals are pure technical and operational nature so it is about details of rule changes. He also said that some of the proposals are expressing more on wishes and projects and future perspectives what they should go for, but not detailed concrete action which can be taken. Other proposals

are already in place and implemented, they've got proposals that they already done. Some [sup-]proposals require the change of statutes. And consequences especially financially are often not fully considered.

Mr. Thumfart has presented the received and approved proposals to the congress, 13 proposals from

JJIF board and the applicants analyzed and discussed these matters. After discussion proposal No 1 for more than one hour we decided together:

- 1. All proposals are welcome and have the intention to develop and move Ju-Jitsu in a better way.
- 2. The proposals will be presented to the congress.
- Technical Commission, JIIF board and Open Working groups will evaluate and work on the given proposals and ideas.
- 4. Specific Items can be enforced by the JJIF board directly.
 For the beginning of 2024 JJIF call for a convention for presentation of these results and final discussion, decision, implementation strategy (if necessary, an extraordinary congress can be conducted)


- There has also been a case of Atypical Finding ("ATF") regarding a Mexican athlete. This is still
 being investigated. Most probably this is a case of meat contamination as this is common in
 Mexico, which would therefore not be an AAF.
- Statistically, this is good news for 2022 with only 1 case compared to 2021 where there were 7
 cases. It does tend to show the efficacy of the JJIF anti-doping programme in combating antidoping. Let's hope that for this year 2023, there will be a nil return.
- 4. There is one 2021 AAF pending case which is taking time to dispose of as there will finally be a hearing of this matter at the request of the athlete and same should be heard before a Hearing Panel quite soon. The details cannot be disclosed for the time being by reason of duty of confidentiality in accordance with the JJIF ADR rules.



























SURVEY SUMMARY

This survey provides plenty of data for further decisions.

It is remarkable that an anonymous survey gives insights in problems that our society was not aware of.

Stains are obviously a bigger problem for our actively competing community than previously thought.

Certain problems are only discussed in safe spaces - even not mentioned with (male) coaches or other people.

That's why these problems are not recognized in public.

→ Changes must be made!



WHY IS IT A PROBLEM?

- The fear of getting blood on your gi during a competition is always on your mind, which is stressful for athletes.
- Often the time between two fights is too short.
 Sometimes the way to the toilet is long, as we have seen recently in Abu Dhabi and Verquin. After a fight there is a way full of securities so you can't take no shortcut, change belts & saftey gear, drink, breath, focus on the next opponent leaving time for nothing else like chaning gis and menstrual products.
- There are cultures in which women on their period are considered unclean and therefore have a hard time.
- Women's sanitary needs are very different from men's.
 Using menstrual products does not ensure a stain-free gi.

PROPOSAL – SPORTING CODE

Sporting Code, 4.1 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements:

→ **New text**: The competitors shall wear a good quality complete white **or black** Ju-Jitsu Gi (as specified in Figure 1), which must be clean and in good order.


